

Digital Council Advisory Board

The Advisory Board is an **independent advisory platform** composed of individuals with expertise in the areas of digitization, technological development, regulation, cybersecurity, innovation, and public administration. Its members provide the think tank with strategic input, expert feedback, and consultation. Although members may differ in their individual opinions, they share the fundamental values and goals on which the Digital Council's work is based, and their participation demonstrates that they consider its activities to be meaningful and necessary.

The primary purpose is to:

- provide the Digital Council with **expert consultation**, feedback, and strategic input;
- help **identify key topics** and trends that should be reflected in the think tank's analytical and advisory work;
- serve as a **peer review** group for selected documents prior to their publication.

Not all outputs undergo formal consultation by the Advisory Board. **All documents in which Advisory Board members were involved will bear the Digital Council Advisory Board symbol**, which declares that either the document was created on the initiative of one or more members of the Advisory Board, that the members received it for consultation and comment during its creation, or that they fully agree with its wording.



For publications marked in this way, all members of the Advisory Board will also have the opportunity, in addition to the above-described involvement in the creation process, to add their comments to the document, which will be included in the final chapter.

The Advisory Board is composed of experts from various professional backgrounds, and it is natural that they may have different views on certain issues. It is therefore neither possible nor desirable to expect that the outputs of the Digital Council will always fully reflect the individual opinions of all members. The Advisory Board serves as a source of expert feedback and inspiration, not as a collective approval body. **The content of publications therefore remains primarily the responsibility of the authors from the Digital Council**, who take individual suggestions and comments into account at their best professional discretion. This is precisely why we indicate the involvement of the Advisory Board, so that it is clear when it has served as a consulting partner and when it is solely the opinion of the Digital Council team.
